ASSISTED SUICIDE: The DPP's (Director of Public Prosecutions) provisional guidelines have now been published and are subject to a public consultation that will close on 16 December 2009. There are a few worrying features: a neutral position between prosecution and non-prosecution; proposals that are open to question and could put vulnerable people at risk of harm especially in cases of terminal or degenerative illness or the incurably disabled.
